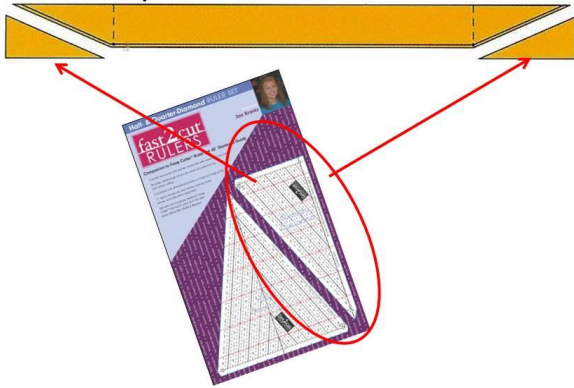

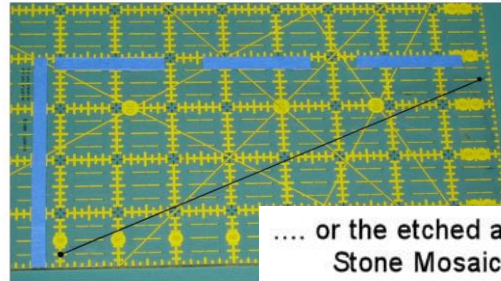
Supplemental Border tips from Jan's slide show in class

Cut border ends with the quarter diamond ruler.....

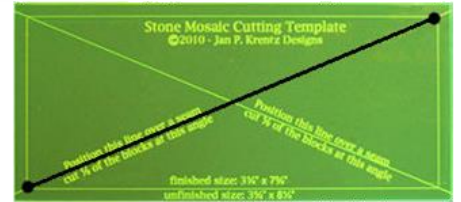

.... Or without quarter-diamond rulers, use the angle on the straight ruler.

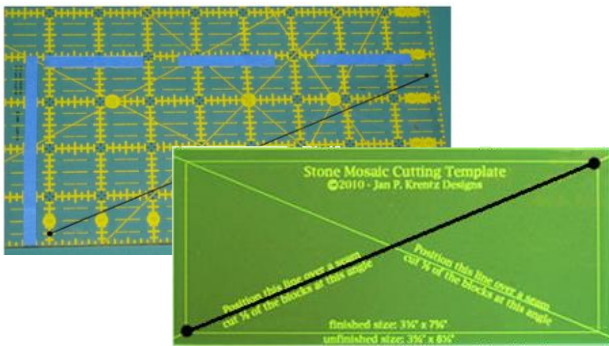


.... or the etched angle on the Stone Mosaic tool....



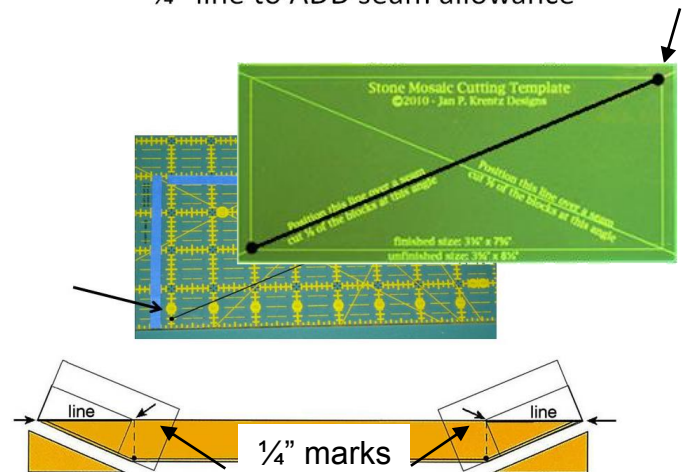

Position the *ink line* or the *etched line* on border's edges

Align the 1/4" marks (dots) with the ruler's 1/4" line to ADD seam allowance



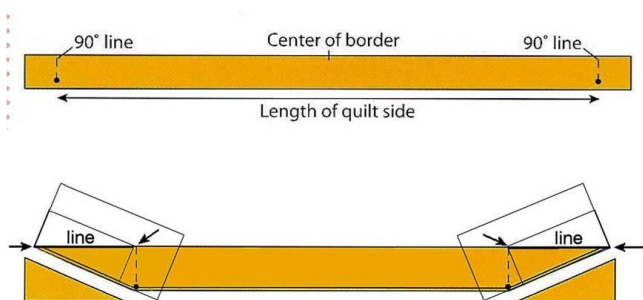

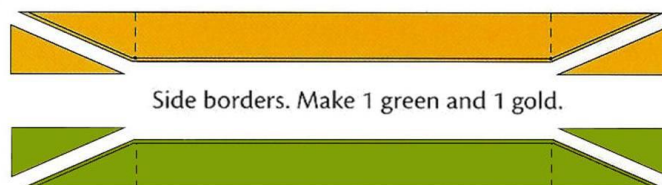

Align the ¼" marks (dots) with the ruler's ¼" line to ADD seam allowance



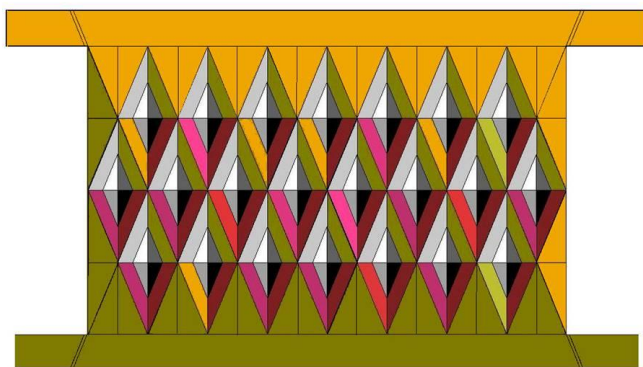

Read the instructions before cutting!
Measure twice.... Cut once!



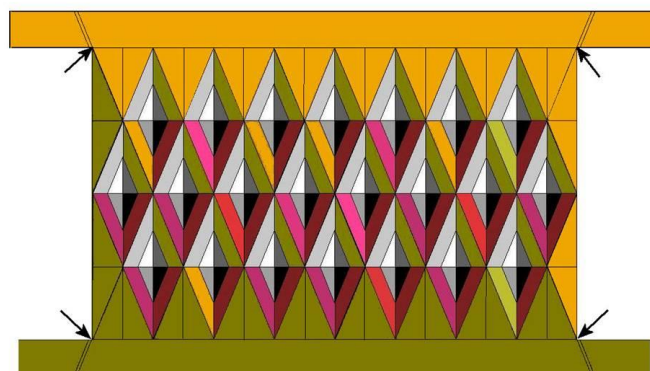

Sew the border strips to the quilt top,
stopping and back-tacking at each dot.



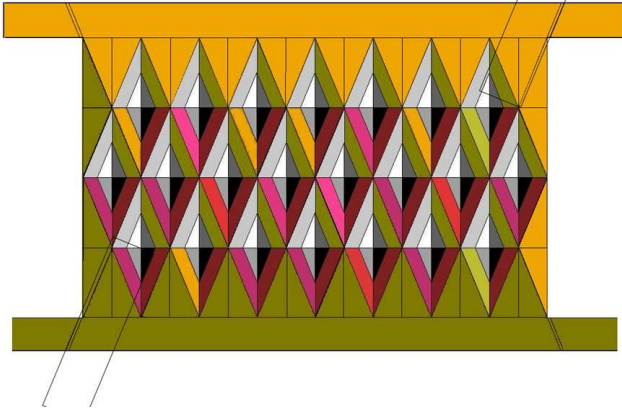

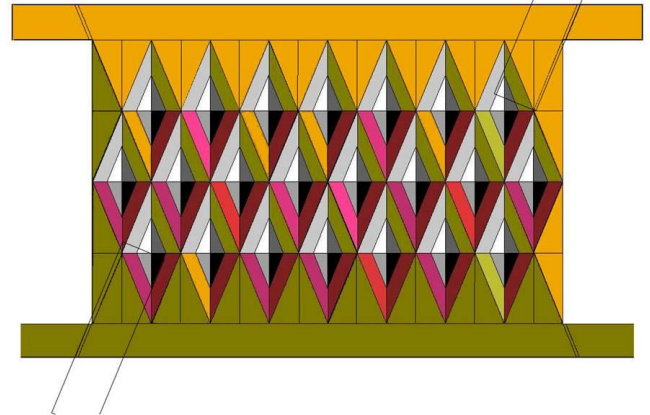

Align a long straight ruler with the angled seam.



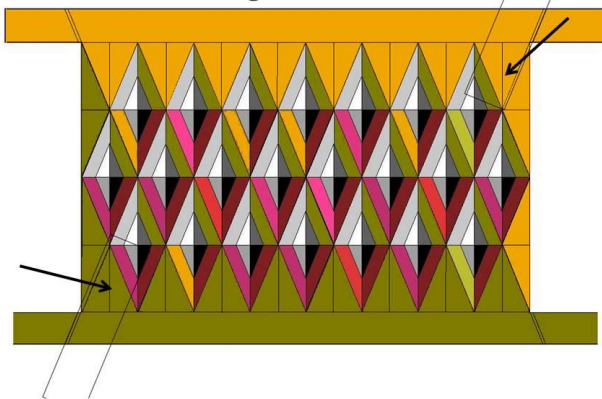

ADD $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.



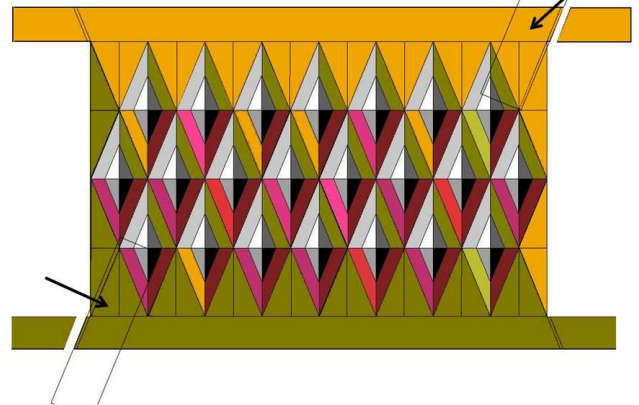

Align a long straight ruler with the angled seam.

Trim away excess leaving $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Repeat for the shorter borders.

7. Mark the top and bottom borders in the same manner, but place the ruler so that the long side is parallel to the 90° line.



Top and bottom borders. Make 1 green and 1 gold.

Using either the Quarter-diamond ruler or Stone Mosaic tool...

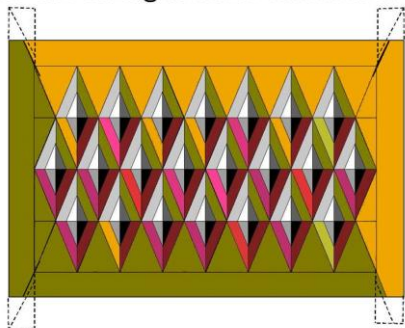
7. Mark the top and bottom borders in the same manner, but place the ruler so that the long side is parallel to the 90° line.

...or the straight-ruler-trim method.

One final construction option for the borders:

Attach all 4 borders, aligning the ¼" seam intersection as in step 8.

Fold the quilt top diagonally, laying two borders right sides together. Mark a line on the border (wrong side) following the seamline from the blocks.

Pin the two borders together, aligning both layers.

Sew the seam, backstitching at the ¼" mark and the outside edge.
